Hello friends,

Growth, transition, impact, generosity... all words that describe the past year at Hastings Family Service. On the next page, get to know the amazing HFS staff who are working with our volunteers to make it all happen. We have 16 staff

members, eight full-time and eight part-time, with nine joining HFS in the past two years. This time of transition provided an opportunity to restructure, increase capacity, and move forward boldly and creatively. I'm so grateful for this team! They work hard and bring fun and energy, new perspectives and skills, and a willingness to always try to find our way to "yes".

The need continues to grow. August was our largest month this year with 428 households/978 people served through our Market food programs, more than tripling our pre-covid numbers. Statewide, over 5.5 million visits were made to Minnesota food shelves in 2022, with one in 11 people unsure where their next meal would come from.

HFS is working hard to identify gaps, increase access, and respond to the growing and changing needs of our community. We can provide help and hope for our neighbors because together, this remarkable staff, the most amazing volunteers, and a supportive community make it happen!

IRA Contributions

If you need to take a required minimum distribution (RMD) from an IRA, consider sending it directly to HFS to reduce your taxable income. Keeping your taxable income lower can reduce the impact to your Social Security and Medicare. Starting in 2023, the age requirement for RMD increased to 73 years. Contact your financial advisor to determine if this is a good option for you!

HFS Expansion Multiplies Impact

HFS expanded into the adjacent building in June of 2022 and the additional space has greatly improved our capacity to expand food programs and provide more food than ever before. The in-person Market re-opened summer of 2022 and we continue to offer the drive-thru option as well. We also added two Market Express dates for smaller food shelf orders each month, and we expanded our Market Cart mobile produce program from visiting one senior living community each month to one each week. With our Market on the Move van, we have added food rescue with Cub and Walmart in addition to Coborn's and Kwik Trip.

Stories of Hope

A neighbor called distressed because his heart medication prescription was more than he could afford. Retired and on a fixed income, his medicare plan leaves him with no coverage through the end of the year. HFS was able to utilize financial assistance to cover the cost, and circumstances made it necessary for emergency services staff Amy Tix to meet him at the pharmacy to pay for the prescription. Our neighbor was relieved and was able to set up additional appointments for food and transportation. Amy told him this is what HFS is all about . . . **neighbors helping neighbors**.
